

Quick and Easy Key Fob

Here are alternate decorating options

Different fabric on each side, no center strip



Add ruffle down center or rick rack



Materials: Background fabric - 3" x 10" strip

Contrast fabric - 1 1/2" x 10" strip

Batting - 1 1/4" x 10" strip

Key Fob hardware – 1 1/4"

1. Lay the contrast fabric wrong side up and press the outside edges to the center of the strip. Set aside. Hint: use a 1/2" bias tape maker.

2. Lay the background fabric wrong side up and center the batting on top. Fold the outside edges up over the batting. The raw edges of the background fabric should be close to the center of the strip. Press. Hint: It will be easier to keep the fabric in place if you use fusible batting OR apply fusible to the background fabric OR batting.
3. Place and center the contrast strip on top of the background fabric strip, making sure to cover the raw edges that are running down the center. Topstitch the contrast strip, sewing on both sides, to the background fabric.

**STOP HERE AND TURN IN THE STRIPS AT THE FRONT TABLE

They will be installed in the metal end-cap hardware later.
